

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Saint Joseph Notre Dame High School is located in the East Bay on the island of Alameda, about four miles south of downtown Oakland. There is easy access to the school from various points within the Bay Area.

DRIVING

Saint Joseph Notre Dame is easily accessible from Highways 880, 980 and 580. There are three exits from Hwy 880 into Alameda – exits 23rd Avenue, Fruitvale and High Street – and three corresponding bridges from Oakland into Alameda. Drivers can also take the Webster Tube from Oakland to Alameda.

CAR POOLS

SJND encourages carpooling for families and students. To facilitate this effort SJND is a member of eRideShare – www.erideshare.com. Families interested in carpooling can register on eRideShare to discover neighbors who are also interested in finding carpool partners.

BART

The nearest BART stop to the SJND campus is the Fruitvale station. Two bus lines (#51 and #63) have stops within a short walking distance to the campus.

BUSES

AC Transit offers bus service throughout the city of Alameda and direct routes from points in Alameda and Berkeley and transfer service from Castro Valley, San Leandro and Hayward. The most commonly used bus lines are #50, #51 and #63. The SJND reception desk sells discounted bus passes to students.
